CHARACTER	COSTUME NEEDED
PIRATE KING	Mixture of pirate and King - a robe, pirate hat, beard? etc. (no shoes on stage)
STOWAWAY	Child-like clothes of a child who really likes pirates. Pirate accessories that are CLEARLY 'fake' and for costumes. (no shoes on stage)

PIRATES OF VARIOUS COLOURED BEARDS	Dress in mainly your assigned beard colour. Bottoms can be black or denim if necessary. Black or brown socks pulled up over pant bottoms or beneath rolled-up pant bottoms to look like boots. Optional pirate or sailor/sea-fairing/nautical accessories - shoulder parrot, sash, hat, peg-leg, hook-hand, gold earing, monocle, bandanas, fake tattoos, etc. Fake beards/facial hair optional - otherwise can be face-painted on (we have this at school).
WHITE BEARD	As above, but with a few santa-esque add-ons. Ms. Tobin is looking for a santa-themed pirate hat)
NO BEARDS	Denim/black bottoms. Black/brown socks pulled up to look like boots. White tank top or button-up shirt. Coloured bandana optional. Simple, non-distracting pirate-ish accessories encouraged but not required. NO PATCHES.
PRISONERS	White/off white old clothing - shirt/tank-top/leggings/pants/shorts, etc. Dress to look tired, hungry and dirty. No accessories. Hair tied up/back so faces show. Bare feet.
CHOIR/ALL OTHERS	Denim or black bottoms. White tops (no logos please!) Can be any kind of top - button-up, tank-top, t-shirt, etc) Black or brown socks



- 6. ARRRRGH ... Time to raid the PANTRY! This year we are asking families attending the Winter Musical on Dec 15th to bring at least two non-perishable items each for our school's Food Bank Drive. So, get in the pirate spirit and raid those pantries for a good cause. This is our small way of giving back to the community at a time when it is much needed. COMMUNICATING STUDENT LEARNING



STUDENT AND FAMILY AFFORDABILITY FUND

The Ministry of Education has provided West Vancouver Schools \$650,000, a one-time funding for us to make the 22/23 school year more affordable for students and families in need. We have now received the funding for our 18 schools and have allocated the money based on the specific needs of each of our school communities.



Our allocation:
