
CSL (COMMUNICATING STUDENT LEARNING) DOCUMENTS

Student CSL documents (Report cards) will be published on the MyEd Parent Portal on Friday March 10th. The last day to access these documents is Tuesday April 11, 2023.

If you have not already done so, please login <u>https://westvancouverschools.ca/family-portal</u> and familiarize yourself with the parent portal. Most of you will have done this last December, but those of you who have not had a chance should have received a reminder email from me earlier this week with instructions on how to do this. These instructions are listed below for your convenience.

- Click <u>https://westvancouverschools.ca/family-portal</u> to log into MyEd BC with your Family Portal account login information this week.
- To initialize your account you will need to replace the temporary password provided. This must be done on a COMPUTER (PC or laptop) and will not work on a smartphone or tablet.

Winter/Spring Hot Lunch

Parents can NOW log onto their Munch-a-lunch accounts and place Hot Lunch Orders for our Winter/Spring Session. We know life changes quickly along with our little one's food preferences, so please note:

- Ordering is left OPEN all semester in the event you want or need to make a change to an existing order or cancel an order all together (This must be done 7 days prior to hot lunch day)
- Orders must be placed at least 7 days prior to the next upcoming lunch date
- If your Child's food preferences change and you want to make a change to their upcoming hot lunch, YOU CAN!
- If you book a vacation or know your child will be away 7 days prior to their hot lunch day, you can cancel the order in your account
- In these cases, just log into your account, cancel the order, and then reorder something different from the menu or keep it canceled.
- If you choose to cancel, a credit will be reflected in your account to use for future orders or if not used up by end of year, your Hot Lunch Coordinator can issue a cheque for the refund.
- If your Child is sick or away on a Hot Lunch Day, please email Jenny/Andrea <u>aundseth@wvschools.ca</u> / <u>IMackenzie@wvschools.ca</u> before lunch that day if you would like them to set it aside for you to pick up later that same day. Otherwise the lunch will be thrown away.

- 3. Review the choices with your child and double check your quantities at the end of the ordering process. Scroll down all the way to the bottom to verify your order then press "Submit My Order". Remember, there are no refunds or changes after the deadline.
- 4. You can pay for your orders by credit card.
- 5. After creating your account, you can return to your account anytime by clicking on "Returning Users click here.
