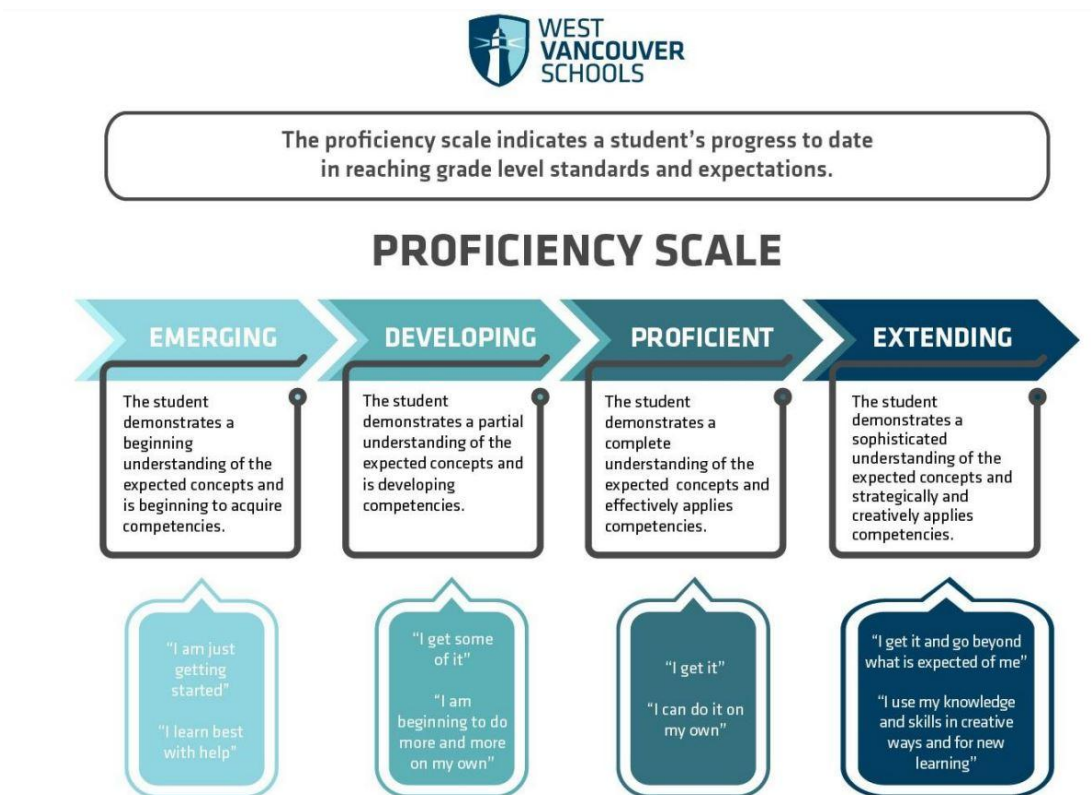
THURSDAY, JUNE 29TH CSL DOCUMENTS PUBLISHED IN MYED

HEADS UP - AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS FOR FALL 2023



NEW PROGRAM ADDED ! Combining the benefits of extracurricular enrichment and after school care, after school programs are organized by parent volunteers, taught by community vendors and approved by school administration.

Vendors must satisfy WVSD's policies on first aid, insurance and criminal record check requirements. They also pay rent. As costs to the vendors are not covered by school fees, tuition is charged and each program's minimum enrollment must be met for the program to run.

It was recently brought to my attention that a few families have allowed their children to join without paying tuition (emails from vendors have not been responded to). If this message happens to reach one of you, **PLEASE** do your part and pay promptly, direct to the vendor, so programs can keep running at our little school!
