STUDENT SAFETY AT DROP OFF PARKING REMINDER NO PARKING IN THE ROUND-ABOUT

Please do not park in the front round-about during drop off or pick up. If you need to get out of your car to help your child with their backpack or coat we kindly ask that you park along Marine Drive and in the lot on the left side of the school.

This roundabout is a drive-through only and vehicles here must always have a driver. Stopping too long, not pulling ahead or parking here can result in congestion which backs up onto Westport and prevents people from turning into and out of the school and creates a dangerous situation for everyone.


