




E-Bulletin EAGLE HARBOUR MONTESSORI FEB 15, 2024

SOME REMINDERS FOR VISITORS COMING TO EAGLE HARBOUR MONTESSORI

All parents/caregivers, visitors and volunteers are required to enter through the front doors of our little school in the woods and report to the school office to sign in if you are visiting **during the school day**. This allows us to know exactly who is in our building at all times.



Parents and caregivers please make prior arrangements with your child's teacher before entering your child's learning space **during the school day.** If you need to drop off a lunch (**this should arrive before 12:05**) or project, these items should be left at the office, so as not to disrupt the learning environment.

Please do not "drop-in" on your child's teacher unless prior arrangements have been made. An email in advance or a call to the school to set up an appointment time is greatly appreciated. Staff are always happy to meet, but advance notice allows for them to give you their full attention at an appropriate time.

Following these guidelines will help keep all of the children safe and protect our learning environments.

DAILY HEALTH CHECK REMINDERS

Daily Health Checks Parents are asked to do daily health checks of children before sending them to school. As flu and cold season is upon us, we ask for your assistance to ensure that your child is healthy and well enough to participate in normal school activities. Parents are also reminded that communicable diseases should be reported to your classroom teacher or to the school office. This would include lice, chicken pox, measles, etc

It's STILL working! Thank you all for your diligence. At the time of publication there were NO reports of lice in our classrooms. Parents are still reminded to continue doing daily health checks of your child's hair and scalp before sending your child to school. RETURNING TO EAGLE HARBOUR MONTESSORI FOR THE 2024 -2025 SCHOOL YEAR?

As we are currently accepting new registrations for the 2024-25 school year, we are trying to predict as closely as possible whether or not we have room for those new students interested in joining our school. We understand that job transfers happen and relocations can occur without much notice; however, please indicate to the best of your knowledge whether your child will NOT be returning to us in September (and we certainly hope THEY will be!). This will greatly assist us in knowing how many spaces are available. Please note that if you are planning to return to EAGLE HARBOUR MONTESSORI, students are expected to be present (at school) by September 5, 2024 to guarantee their spot for the 2024 - 2025. 
