STUDENT VERIFICATION FORMS

Student Verification Forms were sent home on Friday. Parents/guardians are required to review this information and note any changes (or discrepancies in information) before returning it to the school office by **Friday, September 13th**. In order to keep our records current, we request that any changes in citizenship, custody, or residential information be supported by original documentation submitted to the school office. This would include respectively: a Canadian citizenship card or passport; legal custody agreement; a purchase/tenancy agreement and utility bill(s). Please contact the school office if you have any questions.

We recognize that it is a lot of paperwork at a busy time, but ask that you complete them as soon as possible to enable your child to have access to the technology at school and fully participate in events and neighborhood learning walks.
