NOVEMBER 12 PRO-D OFFERING: BABYSITTING COURSE & STAY SAFE COURSE AT GLENEAGLES CH'AXAY

On the Pro-D Day of November 12th, the PAC at Gleneagles Ch'axay Elementary has organized two student courses which will be taught by qualified instructors from Sea 2 Sky Safety Training.





Babysitting Course – suitable for kids aged 11 to 13
Students will learn babysitting skills, safe environment awareness and how to deal with different situations when left with a small child. Cost is \$75.

<u>Stay Safe Course</u> – This is a basic first aid course designed for kids 9 to 13 years old. Kids will learn about being safe when they are without the direct supervision of a parent, along with first aid and awareness skills. Cost is \$60.
