VACANT! PAC CHAIR (time commitment - approx 5 hours a month) CONSIDER SHARING THIS ROLE TO MAKE IT WORK FOR YOU!

The Chairperson is a leadership role and responsible for making sure that each monthly PAC meeting is planned effectively, conducted according to the EHMS Constitution and Bylaws and that matters are dealt with in an orderly, efficient and respectful manner.

VACANT! AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS COORDINATOR

(time commitment - approx 3-4 hours a month)

The After School Programs Coordinator is responsible for sourcing, planning, scheduling and communicating extra-curricular opportunities that can be hosted after school at the school.
