THE PAC AT WORK!



Volunteers Needed!

Each school is responsible for providing volunteers to help ensure the day runs smoothly. Click [here](#) for an overview of volunteer roles. If you've already signed up—or are interested in doing so—please contact your school's Principal or Vice Principal.

- School volunteers should board the bus with students at 8:20 AM.
- Event volunteers must arrive at Terry Fox Field by 9:00 AM and be available until 3:30 PM or later to assist with take-down and clean-up.

General Reminders

- Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather and brings a nutritious lunch, snacks, and plenty of water. Sunscreen and a hat are strongly recommended.
- Students will eat lunch in the stands. While a concession is available, it primarily offers less nutritious options (junk food), and line-ups can be long.
- Each school has an assigned, clearly labeled seating section. Please check with your school to confirm your team's location.
- Parents are welcome to attend and cheer on students—no admission fee is required. Seating is on concrete bleachers without back support, so a blanket or cushion is recommended for comfort.
- Students are expected to demonstrate respectful and responsible behaviour, in line with school and district codes of conduct.
