I. **Call to Order**

1. Meeting called to order at 9:10am.
2. Approval of Feb 2, 2018 minutes – first by Karen, second by Sara.
3. Adoption of Agenda – first by Sara, second by Arissa.

II. **Guest Speaker – Mike Finch, Sentinel Principal**

Mike Finch spoke to parents about the French Immersion program at Sentinel.

III. **EC Administration - Principal's Report**

1. Richard O'Sullivan is coming next week for hip hop classes.
2. Grade 5s and 6s walking to Sentinel for an orchestra rehearsal (North Carolina University strings orchestra).
3. Auditions for Mary Poppins starting next week – hoping to have musical casting complete next week (grade 6 and 7). Grades 3-7 have a number and are included in the cast. Musical is scheduled for late May at Kay Meek (one night only).
4. Grade 7s kicking off Exhibition – their transdisciplinary theme is 'how we express ourselves.'

IV. **Treasurer's Report**

1. We have some extra funds that we are considering moving to a GIC to earn extra interest.
2. Grade 7 Quebec fees – payments to parents have been done.
3. Spending the fall fundraiser funds on purchasing keva blocks and numicons first (based on needs of teachers), then will use the balance to purchase as many chromebooks as possible. We don't know how many chromebooks we will be able to purchase as we only raised \$6,000 of our \$10,000 goal.

 - d. Fundraising goals – this is our biggest fundraiser of the year. Our goal is to fundraise for STEM/ADST again – based on feedback from our teachers and the fact that we did not reach our fall fundraiser goal. STEM/ADST is now part of our curriculum and teachers need a lot of resource support to implement successfully. Specific list of items needed by teachers will follow. Fundraising target it \$15,000.

We are trying to plan a parent speaker who can speak to anxiety. We are also exploring a number of other guest speakers for future meetings.
