Changes to reporting

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As communicated last Spring, the Ministry of Education and Child Care has implemented a new Learning Update Policy which defines and provides direction for the ways our school will be communicating your child's learning. The goal of the Learning Updates is to provide personalized, descriptive feedback to effectively communicate with students, parents, and caregivers about where students are in their learning, next steps, and how families and teachers can work together to support student growth.

The provincial Reporting Policy mandates that students in Kindergarten through Grade 9 will be assessed using the four-point proficiency scale and students in Grade 10 through Grade 12 courses will be assessed using letter grades and percentages. Each term, students at all levels will be sharing self-reflections and making goals around British Columbia's Core Competencies – Communication Skills, Thinking Skills, and Personal and Social Skills.

Teachers will be communicating and reporting throughout the year in the following formats:

- 3 Formal Written Learning Updates (2 Mid-year Learning Updates, and 1 Summary of Learning)
- 2 Informal Learning Updates (ex. Parent-Teacher Conferences, Student-Family-Teacher Conference, Interim Report)

The Ministry of Education and Child Care, responsible for creating reporting requirements, has provided

reporting information for parents and caregivers in the following languages: English, French, Chinese (Simplified and Traditional, Tagalog, Farsi, Urdu, Punjabi Gurmukhi Should you have any further questions, please reach out to me directly at khaves@wvschools.ca.

It's that time of year again! - Stay home if you are sick!

Emergency Release Drill - Thursday, October 19th @ 1:15 pm

This is a simulated emergency drill to practise releasing students to emergency contacts before the regular dismissal time. We practise this in the event of an earthquake or other emergency evacuation.

Have you returned your child(ren)'s verification forms? Who have you listed as an emergency contact for your child? For whom are you listed as an emergency contact?

Please make sure that anyone listed as your child(ren)'s emergency contact is aware of this responsibility. In the event of an emergency release, it would be their responsibility to check-on/pick-up your child if you are unable.

Release Procedures:

- Parent/Caregiver will be directed to the alphabetical "Parent/Caregiver Reception Tables" where
 - they will show their government issued **photo identification**
 - If you have not filled out and returned an emergency contact form (i.e. completed your child(ren)'s verification forms in the white envelope), you will be asked to do so, before a runner can be sent for your child
- A runner will be sent to get your child from their respective classroom while you await them in the "Parent/Caregiver Waiting Area" before leaving the school

All students who are not picked up during the release drill will be dismissed at their usual dismissal time.

Your patience and participation are truly appreciated as we work to ensure the safety of all our Cedardale community.



Once again Cedardale will be providing the opportunity for learners in Grades 2-7 to participate in a series of **Online Mathematics Contests** called the Caribou Cup. The Caribou Mathematics Competition is a world wide online contest that is held six times throughout the school year. The Caribou Cup is the series of all Caribou Contests in one school year. Each participant's ranking in the Caribou Cup is determined by their performance in their best 5 of 6 contests through the school year.

All of previous contests are available for free online as previous tests so learners can prepare. They can access and practice using this site and its resources throughout the year.

Permission forms were sent home on Tuesday for learners in Grades 2-7. Once permission forms have been completed, learners will receive a login code to activate their account for the 2023-2024 year.
