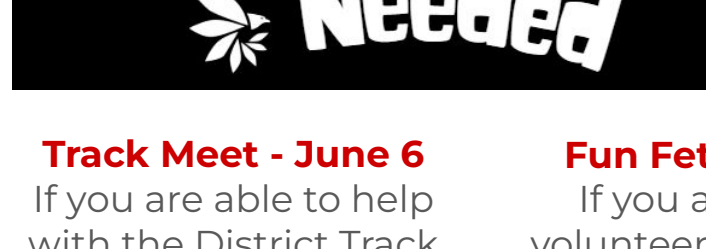

#### Freezie Fridays are back! - Starting TOMORROW May 24th

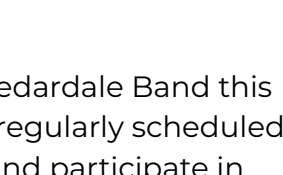

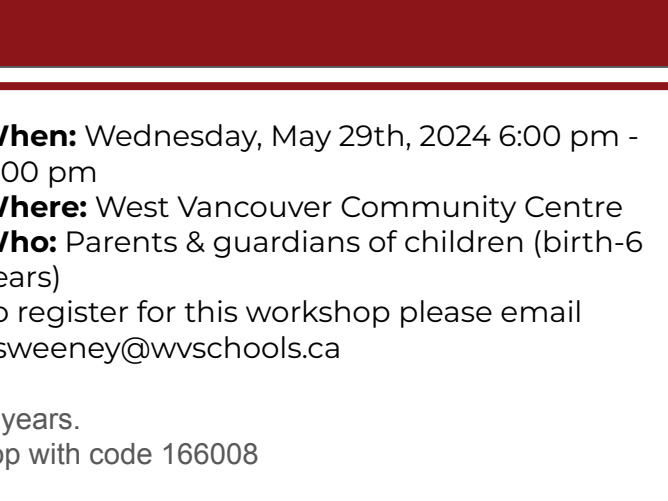
