This is a fantastic way for learners to share their creativity and craftsmanship with our community. Additionally, crafters will keep 50% of their sales, with the remaining 50% going toward a nonprofit of their choice from options like Backpack Buddies, Ocean Ambassadors, or The Christmas Bureau.

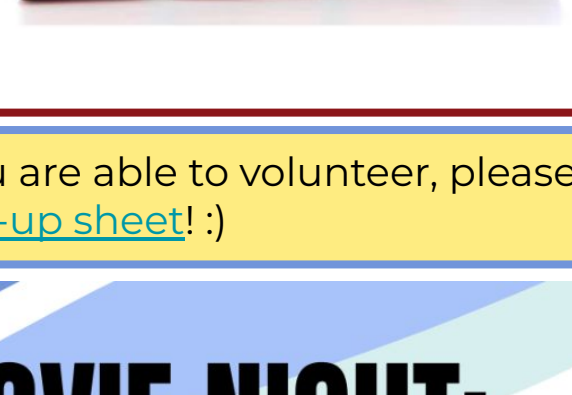

- Gift ribbon

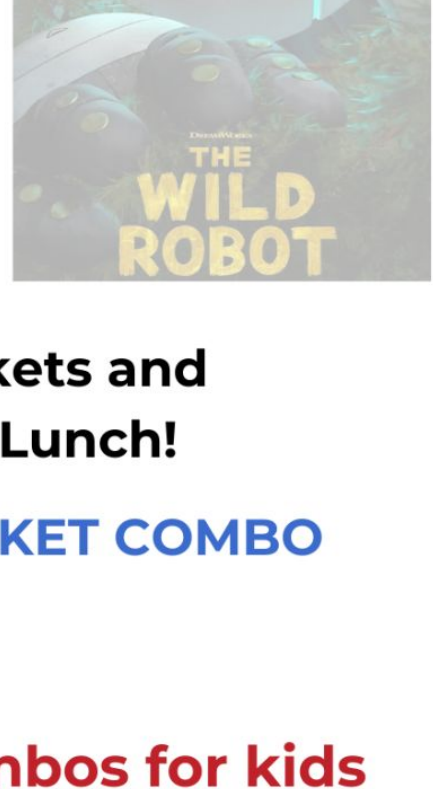


These items can be donated at the Cedardale office until **Friday, December 6th**, but the sooner the better!

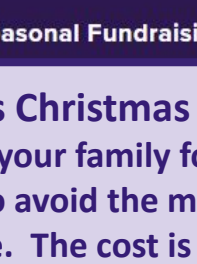

Clear out the bookshelves! Bring a previously-loved book to trade for a new-to-you read!

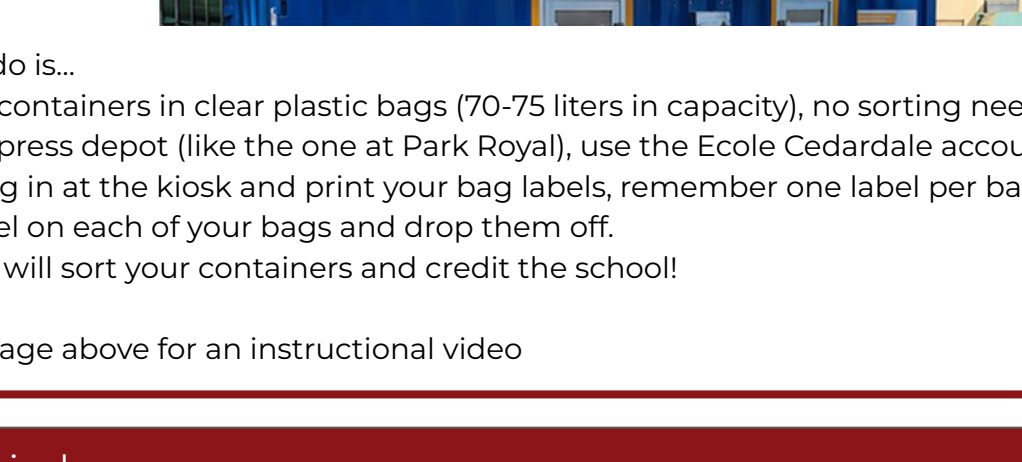

All you have to do is...

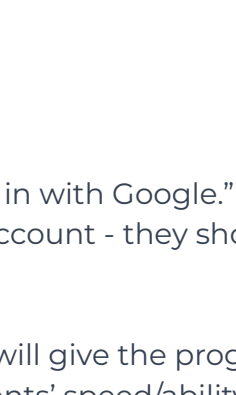
- Put your containers in clear plastic bags (70-75 liters in capacity), no sorting needed!
- At the Express depot (like the one at Park Royal), use the Ecole Cedardale account number 604 981 1390 to log in at the kiosk and print your bag labels, remember one label per bag.
- Put a label on each of your bags and drop them off.
- Return-it will sort your containers and credit the school!

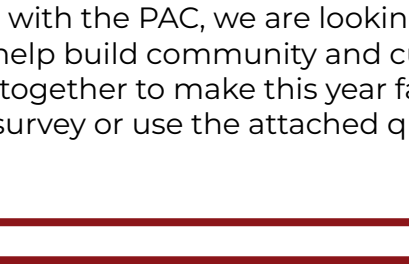
News & Reminders

Playground Use Before and After School

We love to see Cedardale hawks engaging in safe play on the playground after school. The school grounds and playground are instructional spaces until 3:00pm. After 3:00pm, there is no supervision. Parents/caregivers are asked to actively supervise their own children. As per bylaw #3110, no dogs are permitted on the playground.



What is it? Typing Pal School Edition is a web-based application that encourages keyboarding practice for students, from beginner to intermediate. We are making this available to all students from Kindergarten to Grade 9.



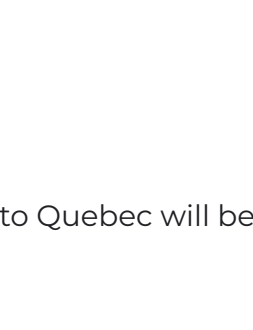
Students should go to the unique url for their school: [Typing Pal](#) and choose "Log in with Google." If students have more than one Google account, they will be asked to choose their account - they should choose the school one.

When students first log in they are prompted to take a diagnostic type of test that will give the program an idea of where to start them. From there, the program will cater to each student's speed/ability.
