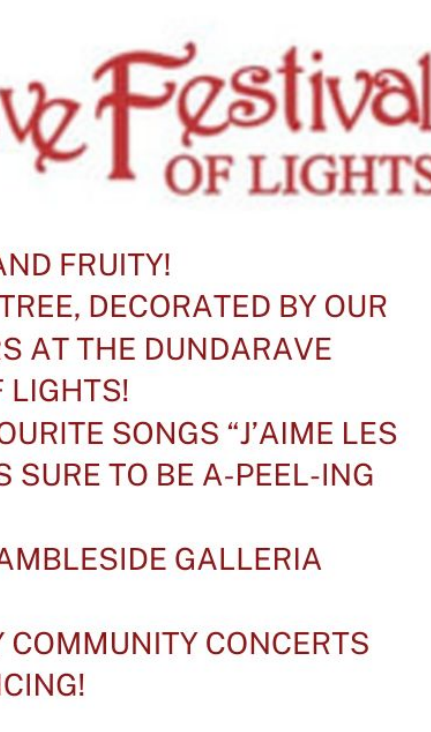

Please be reminded that personal digital devices (cell phones) are for emergencies only. Please make sure devices are turned on silent and remain in purses or pockets! Thank you!

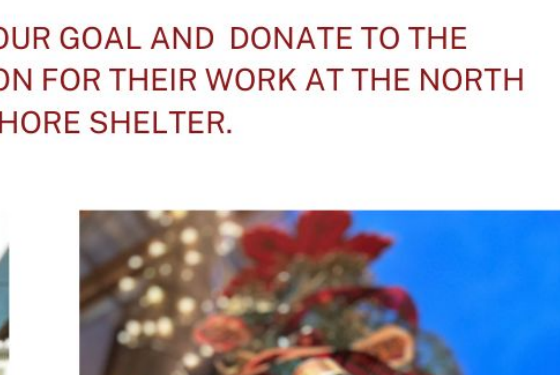

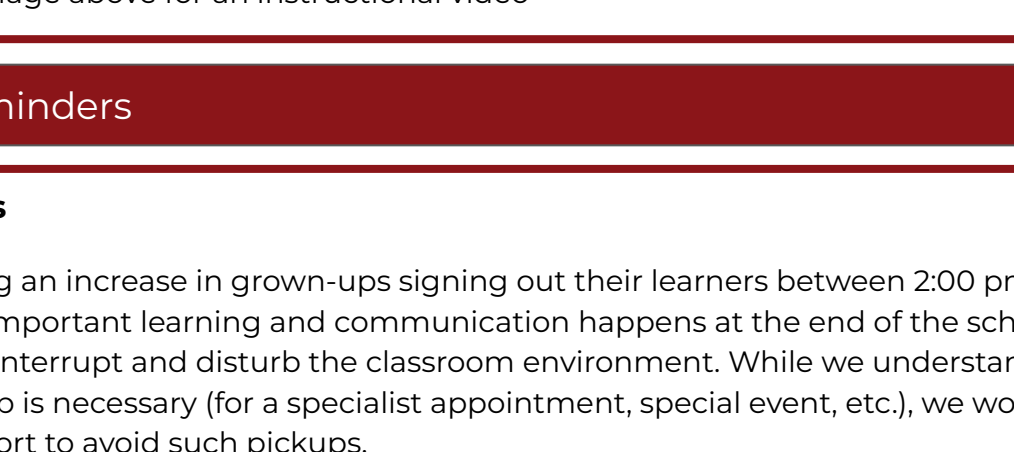


Seasonal Fundraising

- Put a label on each of your bags and drop them off.
- Return-it will sort your containers and credit the school!

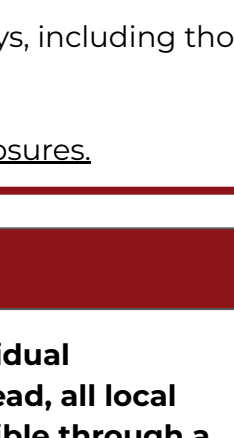
News & Reminders

Early Pickups

We are noticing an increase in grown-ups signing out their learners between 2:00 pm and 2:40 pm on a regular basis. Important learning and communication happens at the end of the school day and these early pick-ups interrupt and disturb the classroom environment. While we understand that sometimes an early pick-up is necessary (for a specialist appointment, special event, etc.), we would ask that you make every effort to avoid such pickups.

Playground Use Before and After School

We love to see Cedardale hawks engaging in safe play on the playground after school. The school grounds and playground are instructional spaces until 3:00pm. After 3:00 pm, there is no supervision. Parents/caregivers are asked to **actively** supervise their own children. As per bylaw #3110, no dogs are permitted on the playground.
