- 4. Treasurer's Report/Financial Update Alama
  - Total expenses to year \$104 985.55
  - Donation received from Lynn Valley Lions Club \$1000
  - Fun Lunch back to pre-covid numbers
  - Gaming grant, program grant given in December
  - Outdoor classroom will be within budget, final invoice not in yet
  - Expecting fun lunch expenses, staff appreciation expenses
- 5. Principal's Update Michelle
  - Grade 7 presented their exhibition today it was the first time parents were able
    to attend at the school the theme was 'Sharing the Planet'. Examples of
    presentation topics included: fast fashion and its effect on sustainability, racism
    in sports, story rriting, animation, hunting all tied into how we share the
    planet.
  - The school ran a **lockdown drill** with the West Van Police department. Had three constables working with the kids about safety hide and seek (this video can be available to parents in desired) this was one of the first times the Gr.1 and K's were included in an (masked) assembly!
  - Dr. Yong Chow general message was about how we continue to support our kids to be functional, happy, and contributing to society. Supporting them to pursue things they are doing well at, but also differentiating their passions from what they are good at.

- Vaccination Clinic: will be timed with the regular Gr.6/7 vaccines arranged through public health nurse. They will add on COVID vaccinations at the same time as an option to parents for first or booster dosage
- Satisfaction Survey will be coming out after Spring Break to kids and parents of Gr.4 & 7 – this gives important data for the school to help with the framework for student learning. One important aspect of this has included making sure children have a sense of belonging.
- Reminder: Purdy's Chocolate Drive!
- Cost of IB is going up, the fees have not gone up in quite some time. District is looking at increasing fees from \$450 to \$500/year (IB requires additional staffing, training, and membership fees) Still to go through budgeting
- Increasing enrollment in Kindergarten next year
  - 20 per class (provincial numbers)
  - Additional classroom will be added the following year, and classes will increase slowly.
  - This will create a change in configuration on the school projections show straight classes K, Gr.1, 2, 3, Combined 4/5 and combined 6/7. Will allow for more choice with larger numbers at a high school level in future.

#### 6. Outdoor Classroom Update - Michelle

- Have been coordaining with Aarman and District for the final inspection in the next few days – no concerns at this time (initial concerns have been rectified)
- Had district gardener on site to finalize things over past week
- Temporary fencing will come down on Friday March.11, new fencing will go in to protect the new plants
- Sherry has been working on the Boulder Monument and there is a space planned for it, and it will be placed during spring break

- Technology Budget: \$2500/year (we have three years worth of budget)
- The Ipads in the school have not been updated in some time, the PAC is looking to use the technology budget for new ones
- Currently have 30 iPads in the building, purchased around 9 years ago. They are no longer updateable and no longer supported by the district.
- Needed mostly by the primary classes (K-4) and Music. They are not being used very much right now because of the troubleshooting issues

- Generally they are not used individually, but in small groups. Very guided group usage.
