#### 4. Outdoor Classroom

#### - Update provided by Damien Clapa

Arman has worked tirelessly to get the design stage done. Used a sloped area to make stadium seating. We got permits awarded early in the summer. Building materials have moved up substantially since COVID, the cost of labour has increased and finding labour has been difficult. To ensure that we were getting the right price, we reached out to a couple of North Shore builders for quotes. We were hoping that a North Shore contractor would be interested in the project in a promotional capacity. We did get confirmation that the budgetary numbers Arman presented were accurate. It was reassuring that our budget is sound. We had a tough choice to make in the summer, do we proceed with an outdoor classroom or pause and wait. We chose to continue and build an outdoor classroom. We had to redefine the project, if the PAC does not want to proceed with Phase 2 then we can keep phase 1. We are recommending that we raise the remaining funds to get the project to the final stage as designed. Recommending

that we raise \$50,000 with a legacy recognition piece for donors. Example of a recognition piece is the Rockridge granite slab with etched names. Ideally, we can fundraise quickly so we don't have to demobilize.

## 5. Budget Presentation

Alma presented the 2021/2022 budget. We need to raise \$50K for the outdoor classroom.

Operating budget will be depleted so we are proposing to have small fundraisers for \$9k to keep operating budget healthy

Fun lunch – the cost of our vendors is much higher than it was, so we will only get about \$10K profit. What we need from Fun Lunch is volume. The more orders placed the better rates we get.

## Program grants

Expenses

- Focusing on outdoor classroom
- The rest of the budget is bare bones
- \$1500 Gr 7 Graduation, lower than previous years in COVID
- Classroom discretionary, half of what we normally do
- Staff appreciation, same as last year

If we raise \$50K and other fundraisers, we will have sufficient money in the operating expenses to cover normal expenditure prior to COVID.

Question from Jasmine re classroom discretionary and how much that gives each classroom – per Michelle, \$200 for each classroom and \$100 for other areas such as Music.
