Getting to the meet: Parents/caregivers are responsible for their child's transportation to Ambleside Park from Cedardale at 3:00pm.

Clothing: Running shoes, black shorts and a red Cedardale t-shirt. *T-shirts are available at the school office (in most sizes) or online at the Cedardale Spirit Wear store for \$25*.

Weather cancellations: Cancellations will be communicated by 1:00pm on the day of the meet.

Remember, it is the parents'/caregivers' responsibility to pick up their child from each meet at 4<u>:45pm</u>. (Come early and cheer us on!)

West Vancouver Elementary Coaches Association Athletic Fees:

Due to the increasing cost of fees associated with running our Elementary Athletics programs in all West Vancouver schools, the West Vancouver Elementary Coaches Association charges \$10 per student per sport.

Payments will be made through School Cash Online. All participating families of students in Grades 3-7 will receive a School Cash Online message saying the payment link for Cross Country fees will be live.

Parking Update: Please note that the District of West Vancouver has implemented pay parking at Ambleside Park effective September 15th. Families attending practices, meets, or events will need to pay for parking at this location. Payment signage and instructions will be clearly posted in the park. West Vancouver residents may apply for a free annual parking pass through the District by providing proof of residency and vehicle registration.
