We will be going on a field trip to the **H.R. MacMillan Space Centre** on **Wednesday, February 11, 2026**. We will be traveling by **bus** and will be away from the school from **9:00am – 2:00pm**.

In our current Unit of Inquiry, “Where We are in Place and Time”, we are learning about how human activities are related to the earth’s natural cycles. The H.R. MacMillan Space Centre programs will provide opportunities for learners to apply curricular competencies such as observation and questioning while developing a more in-depth understanding of earth’s patterns and cycles.

Learners will be participating in the following two programs, and have an opportunity to engage with the Cosmic Courtyard exhibit independently:

- **Our Night Sky:** This collection of three short films made for the One Sky Project features Indigenous perspectives of astronomy, space, time and navigation that have been inspiring minds for millennia: Thunderbird (Diné, Navajo), Celestial Canoe (Innu), Hawaiian Wayfinders.
- **Secrets of the Sky:** Students identify how animals, plants and humans react to the similarities and differences between day, night, and the seasons. They will also make a sky-inspired, take-home craft.

Please ensure your child brings a **packed snack, lunch, and a water bottle** for the trip as we will be eating lunch at the Space Centre. Fun lunch orders **will not** be delivered to the Space Centre; however, fun lunch will be held at the school and will be distributed at the end of the day.
