2. Principal's report

- a. New staff welcomed: M Erickson (Music Gr. 4–7), and Mme Wright (Gr. 4/5); all noted as strong additions to the school community.
- b. Upcoming activities and programs include field trips (HR MacMillan Space Centre, Whistler), improv competitions, bilingual theatre performance, and yoga workshops focused on self-regulation.
- c. The school spirit wear store is open but requires more orders to proceed; families are encouraged to place orders before closing.
- d. Lunar New Year and Nowruz celebrations planned for upcoming months.
- e. School procedures for incidents are guided by the BC School Act, Ministry of Education, and District Administrative Procedures (including Risk and Threat Assessment Procedure 175).
- f. Ongoing student wellbeing supports include the Code of Conduct review, Second Step social-emotional learning program, IB essential agreements, IB learner profile language, and access to a school counsellor twice weekly.
- g. Definitions of conflict, mean behaviour, and bullying were reviewed to clarify differences and ensure a common language among staff and families.
- h. IB Self-Study process underway with strong positive feedback from student surveys regarding safety, belonging, and learning environment. Parents encouraged to complete the anonymous survey in Hawk's Highlights.
- i. Provincial Student Learning Survey data shows improvement in students feeling safe and understanding behaviour expectations.
- j. Families were encouraged to model community rules, support accountability and empathy, and help children build resilience through real-world experiences and reduced screen time (resource: The Anxious Generation).
