

PAC Member Roles

Our Parent Advisory Council (PAC) offers several ways to get involved, ensuring everyone can contribute according to their interests and availability:

- **Executive PAC Positions** hold specific roles or responsibilities within the PAC, providing leadership and oversight in key areas.
 - Would **attend biweekly executive meetings**.
 - This position requires the member to be approved into their role.
 - ♣ Chair
 - ♣ Secretary
 - ♣ Treasurer
 - ♣ DPAC Representative
 - ♣ Fun Lunch Coordinator

- **Executive Members at Large** actively engage in discussions and decision-making on all PAC-related topics.
 - Endeavour to attend **at least 75% of executive meetings**
 - This position requires the member to be approved into their role.
 - ♣ Fun Fete Coordinator
 - ♣ Robot Fete Coordinator
 - ♣ Craft Fair Coordinator
 - ♣ General

- **Committee Members** focus on specific planning initiatives.
 - Only required to attend executive meetings related to their chosen area of commitment (ie: robot fete, fun fete, fundraising, etc).
 - This role would not be required to be voted in.
 - ♣ Fun Lunch Committee
 - ♣ Fun Fete Committee
 - ♣ Robot Fete Committee
 - ♣ Fundraising Committee

This structure allows each of us to participate in a way that best fits our schedule and strengths while helping our PAC run efficiently and inclusively.

- **General PAC Members** automatically includes all grown ups with children attending the school. They are encouraged to attend General PAC meetings and get involved in any volunteering opportunities that arise over the academic year.
 - For general PAC members who would like to become part of the executive PAC, we encourage beginning by attending meetings to identify which role best aligns with your goals and availability.
