Dear Grade 3 Families,

Division 7 and 8 will be participating in an exciting in-class soapstone carving program by Studiostone Creative on Wednesday, March 4<sup>th</sup> 2026.

**Exploring Culture through the Arts**

This art exploration workshop invites our budding artists to 3D carve soapstone in the shape of an orca. Learners will start with a pre-cut shape and with the help of an instructor, learn the fundamentals of stone carving.

**Objectives at the elementary level:**

The workshop is supplemented with BC curriculum corresponding resources (cultural connections to Indigenous culture, carving in Inuit art history and notable Inuit carvers). Through the workshop, learners will:

- Become familiar with objects created by Indigenous peoples for use in daily life or to serve a purpose inspired by ceremonies as part of cultural tradition.
- Explore identity, place, culture and belonging through arts experiences.
- Explore relationships among cultures, communities and the arts.
- Refine ideas, processes and technical skills in a variety of art forms, traditional and contemporary Indigenous arts.
