WEST VANCOUVER SCHOOLS SUMMER LEARNING IN PERSON REGISTRATION FOR SECONDARY COURSES

West Vancouver Schools Summer Learning will be holding an in-person late registration session for all secondary courses with available space on Friday, June 30 from 10:00 – 11:00 am at the Inglewood Learning Center meeting room, which is located at 1735 Inglewood Avenue (the eastern portable at the bottom of the West Vancouver Secondary School campus).

Registration will be available for students currently registered in a West Vancouver School and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. The placement priority order which was in place during online registration does not apply to in-person registration. A list of available courses is indicated below but availability of courses cannot be guaranteed on the day. Please also note that registration for secondary full-credit courses will only be available to students who have just completed Grades 9-11.
