#### Hallowe'en at PJ

Teachers will organize individual activities and celebrations for their class on Tuesday, October 31<sup>st</sup> to enjoy the fun and spirit of Halloween. Please look for more information from your child's teacher. A reminder – if your child chooses to dress up that day, the expectations are:

- Choose costumes that respect inclusivity, kindness and safety
- Costumes should be sensitive to the state of the world right now
- Avoid political statements, stereotypes and cultural appropriation
- No costume masks, no props, absolutely no weapons of any type
- Costumes should not impede students in the learning environment (mobility, distractions) – blow up costumes are not permitted

Kindergarten Registration for 2024/25 School year

Registration for children born in 2019 and who want to attend École Pauline Johnson, opens Monday October 16<sup>th</sup> at 8am. See here for requirements and registration timelines to be entered in the French Immersion Kindergarten Lottery.

Grades 1-7 registration for In District families starts October 16<sup>th</sup> at 8am. Out of District Families can register for Grades 1-7 starting January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Please see here for more details and requirements.

#### **High School – For all Grade 7 Parents**

Many of you have been asking about how the transition to Grade 8 works. Grade 7 Students in West Vancouver Schools will be automatically enrolled in their designated "receiving secondary school" unless families apply and are accepted elsewhere. To clarify:

- Students from Ecole Cedardale and Ecole Pauline Johnson continuing in French Immersion feed into Ecole Sentinel Secondary for Grade 8.
- Students from Ecole Cedardale and Ecole Pauline Johnson choosing to leave French Immersion feed into West Vancouver Secondary School for Grade 8.

For those students who live in Sentinel or Rockridge catchments and would like to attend their catchment school in a non-French Immersion program, you may apply for Grade 8 as of Monday, October 16th, 2023 at 8am.

For those students who wish to continue to one of the designated receiving schools above, you will be asked to complete an intention form declaring your choice of Ecole Sentinel or WVSS. In order for secondary schools to begin planning for next year, we are asking that those intention forms be returned to your school office by Thursday, January 25th, 2024. The form will be distributed to families on Monday October 16<sup>th</sup> 2023.

#### **IMPORTANT:**

Families who wish to have their child attend a school other than their designated receiving school or change their decision during the school year, are able to do so provided space and resources are available. These requests must be made via our online admissions platform according to the timelines noted below and posted on our <u>website</u>. All applications shall be considered as per <u>AP 300 Student Registration</u>, <u>Enrolment and Placement</u>

In-Catchment: 2024-2025 applications accepted October 16th at 8am
