AP 390 - Animals in Schools and on District Facilities

Please note:

- No dogs are allowed on District property during school days from 8am to 5pm, with the exception of:
 - a. Dogs on leash with a parent/guardian during student drop off and pick up; and
 - Assistance Dogs (see below).
- 2. At all times during student drop off and pick up, all dogs on District property must be:
 - a. Licensed:
 - b. Cleaned up after and have their waste removed:
 - Leashed and under adult control (assistance dogs exempt); and
 - d. Kept away from building entrances and play areas.

Should you have an Assistance Dog, please do make an appointment with Mme Zielinski as the rules in West Vancouver for these animals differs than the above.
