With the days getting longer and the weather officially looking more like winter every day, we wanted to remind everyone of the West Vancouver Schools Winter Weather protocols.

West Vancouver Schools endeavours to keep schools open on regular instructional days, including those with accumulating snowfall (Weather Closures and Procedures). Any decision to close schools will be made by the Superintendent and will be based on the safety of students and staff. We aim to communicate any decision to close schools by 6:00 am.

If a school or schools are closed by the Superintendent, staff are not expected to attend those specific site(s) but would be expected to work from home and would contact their families via email.

If schools are open and you are uncomfortable driving in winter conditions, you may wish to arrange to carpool or review your options with respect to taking transit. Transit may be delayed but it is an option for those of you who prefer not to drive. Nothing is consistent about our weather, so it is important to remain current in your knowledge about the weather, school closure status and local driving conditions.
