Measles Vaccinations Prior to Spring Break Travel

Measles is a contagious, airborne virus. There is a high risk of measles cases being brought back to B.C. due to ongoing measles outbreaks globally and decreasing vaccination coverage rates in Canada. <u>Public Health Agency of Canada</u> and the <u>Provincial</u>

<u>Health Officer and the BC Centre for Disease Control</u> have issued statements advising individuals to check their measles immunization records and to vaccinate against measles prior to Spring Break travel. Vaccine appointments can be booked through <u>local public health units</u>.
