Personal Digital Devices (PDD) and Ministry Changes

Thank you to the almost 60 families that came out to my first Principal's Corner on Tuesday where I delved deeper into the Ministry Order and the implications for PJ and BC schools. Your questions were wonderful, and your support is extremely appreciated.

Please be reminded of the following:

- NO cell phone use will be permitted by students on school property, including before and after school.
- NO laptops or tablets will be permitted unless by direct teacher instruction at certain learning times, as tools.
- No smart watches or computer-like watches will be permitted at school.
- √ What can you as parents do to support this provincial initiative?
- ✓ Understand the digital device expectations at your child's school
- ✓ Support and encourage your child's appropriate use of digital tools
- ✓ Refrain from contacting your child during the school day if it is important, call
 the school office
- ✓ Personally model and encourage digital device use, limitations and boundaries (appropriateness, when and where, etc.)
- ✓ Avoid using your devices on school grounds at drop-off and pick-up instead, connect with your child and with other families!

Notice of Collection:

The information on these forms is collected under the authority of the School Act and the BC Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA) and pursuant to West Vancouver Schools (School District No. 45 West Vancouver) Administrative Procedures (AP) 180, 185, and 320. The information and consent collected will be used by the School District for the purposes of delivering and administering educational programs and activities for students, accommodating student needs, communicating with parents and students, ensuring compliance with school rules and regulations, ensuring order and safety at school, evaluating student performance, and complying with the School District's legal, regulatory, and administrative requirements. If you have any questions or concerns about the collection, use or disclosure of the personal information collected, please contact the school principal.

Emergency Release Form for the 2024-2025 School year - REQUIRED

This form is required to be filled out each school year and is to determine who is allowed to pick up your children in the event of an emergency, a student release (real or a drill), or on any school day that a parent is unable.

Please ensure that any Alternate Guardians you add to the form have **both first and** last legal names and have photo ID to support this.
