 Use positive language: Emphasize the value and potential of all children.

**Inclusivity Corner** 

- Promote diversity and inclusion: Create opportunities for children to learn about and celebrate different cultures,
- identities, and abilities. Be a role model: Use inclusive language yourself and
- model respectful behavior. • Create a safe space: Ensure that all children feel safe to

- Instead of: "Boys should be strong and brave."

  - Use: "Everyone can be brave in their own way."

  - Instead of: "Girls are good at arts and crafts." Use: "People have different talents and interests."
  - Use: "He is a child who may need a little more time to warm up."

Instead of: "He is very shy."

Instead of: "They are a family."
