# Traffic Reminders for Morning Drop-off!

Mornings at and around PJ are busy! Having students arrive safely is of course, our priority. Families are reminded that the "Drop and Go" zones along Jefferson and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street (in front of the school) are for "drop and go" only. This means, parents should not be getting out of vehicles, but students are hopping out and walking themselves in. If you are needing more time, or to walk your child(ren) in, please park on one of the streets around the school.

This morning, there were several students dropped off on Jefferson who then cut across the road/traffic to get to the school. Students should use designated crosswalks (at the intersection of 22<sup>nd</sup> & Jefferson OR at along Jefferson by the top of the playground) to ensure they are safe in the road. 
## Parent Literacy Workshop
