

English Language Learning (ELL) Program

- Language adapted (LA) courses are offered in English Language Arts,
 Science, and Social Studies
- Students are recommended to ELL classes based on academic achievement in grade 8, teacher recommendation, and Spring/Fall ELL assessments
- Pace and workload are adjusted for greater accessibility

- **Learning outcomes** are the **same** as regular classes
- "Language Adapted" does NOT appear on student transcript
- ELL courses do **NOT** limit post-secondary opportunities
