- 1. Cathy started the meeting by welcoming all to Sentinel PAC and introducing all PAC executives and members at large.
- 2. Approval of the agenda and minutes for September 2022. Motion to approve the agenda and the minutes first by Tonia Liao and Second by Shabnam Taheri. All in favour.
- 3. Mr. Finch, Sentinel's Principal:
- a. Several hundred parents came to meet the teacher on the night on September 21. PAC hosted a welcome to Sentinel event in the cafe followed by a very well-received Meet the Teacher night. Our kids guided their parents around, and they did a great job.
- b. Terry Fox Run on September 22. All students and staff attended Sentinel community and raised over \$3600, a new record set for funds raised.
- c. Truth & Reconciliation week (September 26 29).

 Sentinel's Indigenous Ed. Committee, led by several students and staff, organized a number of activities and events that the school participated in. Brade Baker came to school and spoke to students. Brade supported and answered lots of questions.
- d. Grade 12 Information Night on Oct. 4. About 150 parents of graduating students came to learn more about the year ahead. We discussed what grade 12 would work on.
- e. Grade 12 meetings (Grad Chats). All grade 12's had met and heard about the many opportunities that lie ahead, tips for being organized and time management, events, and safety. We encourage parents to have open conversations with kids and try to be positive and engaged.
- f. Grade 9 immunizations on Oct. 11. All are encouraged to take the COVID Booster and keep our school safe.
- g. Parents Teacher conferences coming up tomorrow (Thursday, October 13): Focus on 4 courses for this semester. (virtual meeting 1:30=4:30pm)
- h. Drive safe to school: Work is still being done to try and reduce the traffic congestion in the mornings and after school. Students/Parents doing a better job with regard to finding other ways to get to school. Some students bike and scooter to school. We can still do better.

- j. Grad Semi Formal on Nov. 4 at "The View" in North Vancouver.
- k. Honor Roll: Grades 8 & 9 will no longer have grades or percentages on their report card. Sentinel staff is looking into how to recognize student achievement, Honour Roll is phasing out. Only Grade 12 will have an Honor Roll.
- l. Field Trips As mentioned before, Field Trips are a go. Students/Parents can expect an increase, in some cases a significant increase in the cost of these additional learning opportunities.
- m. Role of counselor: we have the best counseling team at Sentinel. 50/50 split for counselors to provide Guidance and Social/ Emotional support. Each counselor has a caseload in excess of 300 students.
