2. Grade 10 Graduation Literacy Assessment: Oct 31 - Nov 4

All Grade 10 Sentinel students will be writing the Grade 10 Literacy Assessment at our school. This assessment is required for graduation purposes. Students will be

provided with their exam date and time this week. **Students should prepare for this exam**.
