2. Ministry of Education Affordability Funding

The Ministry of Education has provided West Vancouver Schools a one-time funding of \$650,000 to help us make the 22/23 school year more affordable for students and families in need. Our allocation will allow us to cover costs for school fees, school supplies or other school related costs for students in need. Families should reach out to Mr. Finch if any financial support is needed for school-based supplies, fees or activities.

3. Grade 12 Graduation Literacy Assessment: Please Read!

All Grade 12 Sentinel students will be writing the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment this school year - this assessment is required for graduation. Your first opportunity to complete this assessment is January 23rd – 27th, 2023. All Grade 12 students will be registered to complete the assessment during this period and we recommend you complete it in January. The Ministry of Education allows students three opportunities to complete the assessment if desired. If you wish to postpone writing the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment until the April exam session, please contact Mr. Shawn Anderson at shawnanderson@wvschools.ca with your name and intention to postpone to April 2023.

Students will be provided with their exam date and time in early January 2023.

All Grade 12 students should try the sample exams (printed or online) and review the scoring guide. Developing a familiarity with the types of exam questions and computer interface will support students to be successful in this exam.


