# 7. Summer Enrichment Opportunities

Firstly, we are offering the Red Cross Babysitter's Course to students 11-17 years old. They will learn basic supervision and emergency procedures in a hands-on course designed for youth who are home alone or responsible for other children. Successful completion of a final quiz, along with 100% attendance will be required to receive a Red Cross Babysitter's Certificate. Youth Services Camps and Leadership Programs – 2023

Our second program is the Youth Recreation Employment Readiness Program, geared towards 14-19 year old's. This is the perfect way to gain employment training and work experience this summer. The three day training will include HIGH FIVE Certification and loads of leadership and employment readiness components. After training, the youth will be placed at a West Vancouver Summer Camp practicum where there will be opportunity for further skill development. Upon successful completion of the practicum, a letter of completion will be received, and students will be invited to participate in further resume building and employment readiness workshops to round out their learning.
