#### **1. Student Orientation First Day of School**

The students first day of school will be a staggered start based on Grade. All students will be receiving an email this Friday with their Homeroom class and teacher information. In the Period 1 Homeroom class students will receive their full Class Schedule, School Calendar, Agenda, and lock (Grade 8s and new students only. Grade 9s, 10s and 11s should bring their locks from previous years). There will be lots of assistance on arrival to make sure students know where they are going to get to their Homeroom class in the school.

- Grade 8s: 8:30 am - 10:30 am (Gym & then the Homeroom Period 1)
- Grade 9s: 9:00 am - 10:00 am (Homeroom Period 1)

- Grade 10s: 10:00 am - 11:00 am (Homeroom Period 1)
- Grade 11s: 11:00 am - 12:00 pm (Homeroom Period 1)
- Grade 12s: 12:00 pm - 2:00 pm (please go direct to courtyard for the Grad 2024 BBQ)

## **2. Policies and Procedures**

Please be aware that a new P+P form **MUST** be completed for each student, every school year. Without a completed form, students are not permitted to access their Google classrooms, have their photos included in the yearbook etc. Permissions expire on August 31<sup>st</sup> each year. This form requires a Parent login and Password.

If you have previously created an account to complete the form last year, the account is the same. If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it. After you have logged in, you have the option to either update a P+P form created last year or start a new one.

Road closures will impact vehicle access to Sentinel Secondary over the next several weeks as part of the Glenmore Voltage Conversion Electrical System Upgrades by BC Hydro.

Drivers can expect a **full road closure on Cross Creek Rd., between Chartwell Drive and Hyland Drive** ([see map attached](#)). This closure will be in effect 24 hours a day. Detour signage and traffic control personnel will be stationed along Cross Creek Rd to facilitate traffic flow. Please find attached and read a very important [Grad Activity letter](#) from our Principal, Mr. Finch.

On Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, Grade 12's please go direct to the courtyard for the Grad 2024 BBQ at 12:00 pm to kick off the new school year!

**Below is a list of our typical grad events and their costs:**

- A. Theme days - one per month (minimal costs for costumes)
- B. Grad wear (optional) - purchased in the fall and includes t-shirts \$25, hoodies \$55 and sweats \$40
- C. Semi Formal (Location TBD) - in the fall and historically costs \$100- **grads and dates only**
- D. Winter Formal (at Sentinel) - in January and costs ~\$50 (grade 11s and 12s can attend)
- E. Grad photos (Artona)-in the fall \$60 sitting fee for all students, photo packages are \$200-\$250
- F. Grad Carnival-in the spring, PAC has historically helped fund this to keep cost to ~\$10-15
- G. Banquet (Vancouver Convention Centre) - in June and costs \$150 per grad/guest-grads/dates and parents can attend
- H. Commencement (at the Westside Church) - in June and \$20 per person-no limit (**grads don't pay**)
