2. Policies and Procedures – ACTION REQUIRED deadline October 1

Please be aware that a new P+P form MUST be completed for each student, every school year. Without a completed form, students are not permitted to access their Google classrooms, have their photos included in the yearbook etc. Permissions expire on August 31st each year. This form requires a Parent login and Password.

If you created an account to complete the form last year, the account is the same. If you have forgotten your password, you can follow the instructions to reset it. 3. National Day for Truth and Reconciliation September 30th

Public Holiday is Monday October 2nd. This day honors the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process. Both the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day take place on September 30. Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family, and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters".

Sentinel will be honoring Orange Shirt Day by asking all students to wear an orange shirt on Friday, September 29th.

16. Cross Creek Road Closures

Road closures will impact vehicle access to Sentinel Secondary over the next several weeks as part of the Glenmore Voltage Conversion Electrical System Upgrades by BC Hydro. Drivers can expect a **full road closure on Cross Creek Rd., between Chartwell Drive and Hyland Drive** (see map attached). This closure will be in effect 24 hours a day. Detour signage and traffic control personnel will be stationed along Cross Creek Rd to facilitate traffic flow.
