C. Cross Creek Road Closures

Road closures will impact vehicle access to Sentinel Secondary over the next several weeks as part of the Glenmore Voltage Conversion Electrical System Upgrades by BC Hydro. Drivers can expect a **full road closure on Cross Creek Rd.**, **between Chartwell Drive and Hyland Drive** (see map attached). This closure will be in effect 24 hours a day.
