# 4. Grade 12 Graduation Literacy and Evaluation de literatie de la 12 année Assessments.

All Grade 12 Sentinel students will be writing the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment this school year - this assessment is required for graduation. Your first opportunity to complete this assessment is January 15th – 26th, 2024. All Grade 12 students will be registered to complete the assessment during this period. The Ministry of Education allows students three opportunities to complete the assessment if desired. French Immersion Grade 12 students will also be completing the Evaluation de literatie de la 12 annee Assessments in January as well. The oral component of the assessment will take place on January 16th during their FRAL class. The written component is scheduled for January 25th, 2024. Students will be provided with their exam date and time mid December 2023.

#### Applications for the 2024-2025 school year are NOW OPEN

FAST is a young lifeguard education program that allows students to develop the essential skills to be successful and confident lifeguards. At the completion of the FAST program students will have obtained all the required certification prerequisites necessary to enroll in the National Lifeguard Course, which students can take independently when they are 15 years of age or older. Completion of the National Lifeguard Course is the final credential necessary to qualify an individual to work as a lifeguard. In addition to developing strong first aid skills, the FAST program also focuses on providing students with a practical foundation in resistance and cardiovascular training, swimming, stroke-development, and leadership.
