The **Student Learning Survey 2024** is to be completed by May 3rd, 2024. The Provincial Student Learning Survey gathers information on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and

provincial perspective. It will be administered to students in Grades 10 and 12, their parents/guardians/caregivers, and all school staff. The surveys contain standard questions for the province. It is simple, secure, and can be accessed by selecting the school district and school name where your child attends school.

3. Course Request Verification Process – Grade 8 thru 11

This is the final step in the course selection process and once course requests are verified, the timetable will be created. It is essential that students take this final opportunity to verify that their course requests are accurate for the 2024-2025 school year.

To verify courses, students should log in to their MyEd Login account to view their requests. Please note that listed courses are requests and cannot be confirmed until the timetable is set in September.

- If it seems like you are missing courses, click "exit entry mode" in the top left-hand corner, and that should fix it.

If your courses are correct, you do not need to do anything. If you would like to request any changes to your requested courses, please fill out this <u>Google Form</u>.

The deadline to submit the form is Friday, May 3rd at 3pm.

- Counsellors are not able to make course request changes via email, phone, or in person.
- If the course requested is at capacity, the student will be placed on a waitlist. If you are not contacted, you may assume that all changes have been made.
