<b>24 + 11</b> Classrooms + Clubs   Teams   Programs	<b>Wish-List</b> Every year PAC funds things that normally fall outside the school budget	Students and teachers have the resources they need to keep the classroom and programs running. Items funded including sr girls volleyball provincials trip (we won!), musical instrument, teaching aids, contest fee subsidy, books, etc...!
<b>\$5K</b> for Field Trips	<b>Field Trip</b> New initiative from PAC to enrich student learning through field trips	\$5000 has been given to school administrator for funding upcoming field trips in 2024-25
<b>\$17K</b> for Social Spaces	<b>Social Spaces</b> Raise funds to multi-year projects that enhance school environment	\$17000 has been given to school administrator for use in creating 3-4 student social spaces this summer! Four new bike racks were installed to encourage alternative transportation
<b>300+</b> parent attendees equipped	<b>Parent Education</b> 5 sessions were held to equip parents with common parenting challenges	Over 300 parent attendees across three secondary schools in WV were equipped over the course of five sessions, covering important topics like mental health, communication, technology.
