4. Student Vote Results

Last week 650 Sentinel students voted in a parallel Student Vote election organized through CIVIX after researching the views and platforms of the candidates and parties on issues that are important to them. Part of this research included a Candidates meeting in the Sentinel theatre with candidates answering student questions in front of an audience of 250 students from Sentinel and WVSS. The Sentinel vote reflected the vote in the adult election, with Lynne Block of the conservative party being elected with 39.7% of the vote. Full results can be found here Province wide, Sentinel was one of over 1000 schools and 150,000 students across BC who participated in the Student Vote program. Again, these results were like the adult vote with the NDP winning a minority government (44) seats over the Conservatives with 40 and Greens with 9. Full results can be found here.
