January 2025 assessment session results are now available for the Grade 12 Literacy Assessment (LTE12) and Évaluation de littératie de la 12^e année – Français langue seconde – immersion (LTF12), and any Grade 10 numeracy and literacy assessments. Students can access their results on the MyEd portal. Alternatively results can be seen on the "Graduation Assessment/Provincial Examinations" link after logging in to your account on the <u>StudentTranscripts Service (STS)</u>. Students wishing to re-write an assessment in April or June should inform the Office as soon as possible.
