#### 1. AP Exams May 5<sup>th</sup> – May 16<sup>th</sup>

Sentinel students enrolled in Advanced Placement Courses are due to write AP exams between Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup> – Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. AP exams are administered by the College Board in the US and Canada. AP courses are offered in a variety of subjects, including English, math, sciences, social studies, fine and performing arts, languages, and computer science. AP Scaling system is from 1-5 and Grade reports are available online to students, schools, and colleges in July. Please see a list of the 2025 AP Exams and scheduled exam times [HERE](#).
