2. Student Orientation Opening Day of School - Tuesday, September 2nd

- The students' first day of school on Tuesday will be a staggered start time based on Grade.
- All students will be receiving an email this Friday / weekend with their Homeroom class and teacher information. There will be lots of assistance Tuesday to make sure students know where to locate their Homeroom class.
- In their Homeroom class (1-1) students will receive their Student Verification form (to be reviewed by parents, signed and returned), Class Schedule, School Calendar, Agenda, and lock & locker. Only Grade 8s and new students are given a locker.
- Note: Grade 9-12 students have not been assigned a locker but may request a locker. See "Lockers" below for instructions.

3. Withdrawals and School Confirmation & Enrolment for 2025-2026

If your child is **no** longer planning to attend Sentinel this school year, we ask that parents email sentinel@wvschool.ca. as soon as possible. You can also indicate that you are withdrawing your child by completing THIS FORM and emailing it to sentinel@wvschool.ca. In addition, to confirm your child's spot at Sentinel, we require that **all students attend their** classes no later than Thursday, September 5th. If there are extenuating circumstances whereby your child will not be in attendance the first week of school, we ask that a parent reach out by email to sentinel@wvschool.ca at your earliest indicating the expected date of return.

4. Policies and Procedures (P + P) Form – Action Required ASAP!!

Please be aware that a new P+P form MUST be completed for <u>each student</u>, <u>every school year</u>. It is **ESSENTIAL** that parents complete this form as soon as possible and ideally PRIOR to **September 2**, 2025.

- Without a completed form, students will **not** be permitted to access their Google classrooms, have their photos included in the yearbook, attend field trips, etc.
- This form requires a parent login and password.
- If you previously created an account, the account login/ password is the same.
- If you have forgotten your password, please follow the instructions on the link to reset it.
- After you have logged in, you may either update last year's P+P form or start a new one.

Grade 8

All grade 8s have been assigned a locker and will receive a lock and their assigned locker in their 1-1 class. Students MUST use the lock and locker assigned to them. Students may not use personal locks. Students are to keep their lock for their entire high school experience.

Grade 9-12

Students in grades 9-12 have not been assigned a locker but may request a locker at the link below. Locker assignments will be assigned in the week of September 8th ONLY if the student has filled out the request form. The assigned locker number will be emailed to the student during the second week of school. Students MAY NOT use an unassigned locker. Any student who uses an unassigned locker will have their items removed. Students are to use the lock the school has given them in a previous year. If a student needs a lock, please go to the accounting office.

Please find attached and read a very important <u>Grade Activity Letter</u> from our Principal, Mr. Finch. On Tuesday, September 2nd, Grade 12's please go direct to the courtyard for the **Grad 2026 BBQ** at 12:00pm to kick off the new school year!

Below is a list of our typical grad events in the past and their estimated costs:

- Theme days one per month (minimal costs for costumes)
- Grad wear (optional) purchased in the fall and includes t-shirts, hoodies, and sweats
- Semi Formal (The Pinnacle, @Nov. 1st) historically costs \$110 (Grads and dates only)
- Winter Formal (at Sentinel) in January and costs ~\$50 (Grades 11s and 12s can attend)
- Grad photos (Artona)-in the fall \$60 sitting fee for all students, photo packages are \$200-\$250
- Grad Carnival-in the spring, PAC has historically helped fund this to keep cost to ~\$10-15
- Banquet (Vancouver Convention Centre) in June and costs approx. \$150 per grad/guest-grads/dates and parents can attend.
- Commencement (at the Westside Church) in June and approx. \$20- \$25 per person-no limit (free to grads)
