Policies and Procedures Form – Action Required ASAP!!

Please be aware that a new P+P form MUST be completed for <u>each student</u>, <u>every school</u> <u>year</u>. Without a completed form, students will not be permitted to access their Google classrooms, have their photos included in the yearbook etc. This form requires a Parent login and Password. If you have previously created an account to complete the form last year, the account is the same. If you have forgotten your password, please follow the instructions on the link to reset it. STUDENT VERIFICATION FORM

Grads of 2026

Below is a list of our typical grad events and their estimated costs:

• Theme days - one per month (minimal costs for costumes)

- Grad wear (optional) purchased in the fall and includes t-shirts \$25, hoodies \$55 and sweats \$40
- Semi Formal (The Pinnacle, October 17th,2025) historically costs \$110 (Grads and dates only)
- Winter Formal (at Sentinel) in January and costs ~\$50 (Grades 11s and 12s can attend)
- Grad photos (Artona)-in the fall \$60 sitting fee for all students, photo packages are \$200-\$250
- Grad Carnival-in the spring, PAC has historically helped fund this to keep cost to ~\$10-15
- Banquet (Vancouver Convention Centre) in June and costs \$150-\$170 per grad/guest-grads/dates and parents can attend. Note: We will be surveying students and families in the next few weeks to determine anticipated numbers for Banquet,
- Commencement (at the Westside Church) in June and \$25 per person-no limit (free to grads)

Attendance Notifications – Parent Guide

We kindly ask parents and guardians to notify the school of any **absences**, **late arrivals**, **or early dismissals**.

- Email all attendance-related matters to: sentinelattendance@wvschools.ca
- When emailing, please include:
 - o Student's full legal name and grade
 - o **Time** of absence, late arrival, or early dismissal
 - Reason for the absence

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

Please send emails by 2:30pm on the day of the absence.

If an email is not received by this time, an automatic attendance mark may be applied, and a phone call may be made to the parent/guardian by the end of the day.

Steps to Follow for Specific Situations

1. Absence / Illness

Notify us via email so your student can be marked Absent–Excused

2. Late Arrival

- Students arriving late should go directly to class
- Notify us via email so your student can be marked Late–Excused

3. Early Dismissal

- Notify us via email with dismissal the time so your student can be marked Dismissed-Excused
- Coaches will notify us for school spots early dismissal but feel free to reach out if you have questions.
- 4. **Long-Term Absence** (more than 5 school days)

Please complete the **fillable Long Term Absence Form** and return it to the office.

Our 4-Week Upcoming Anxiety Workshop, beginning on October 14th, 2025, from 6:00 pm-7:30 pm at John Braithwaite Community Centre.
