Thank you to Allison Schatz who has worked tirelessly to set up hot lunch. We have changed some of the vendors and are looking to offer a new wider range of healthier options while supporting local business. Some of the small steps we are implementing are healthier options, reduced sugar, better compostable containers or o-zero waste and no straws.

We are excited to introduce Foodie Kids (under new ownership), Feed Me Fit and Blended for you. We are taking a hiatus from a couple of vendors such as Subway and Sushi however, there will still be a sub sandwich and sushi option offered through Foodie Kids. We are also exploring a shorter, more frequent ordering system that matches the school terms and will be asking for your feedback on the changes.
