MyEd BC Family Portal

Student Learning Updates (report cards) for Term 2 will be published on **Friday, March 15th at GEC and Thursday, March 14th at LB** through the MyEd BC Family Portal. Most parents will be familiar with this site, but if you are a <u>new family</u> to our school District, you will have received an email from the MyEd BC server last week inviting you to initialize your account. Please follow the instructions in that email carefully to initialize the account by replacing the temporary password. This must be done on a COMPUTER and will not work on a phone or tablet. More information will be emailed to parents soon, so look for this important info coming your way.

The Family Portal is where all parents will go to access their child's Learning Update as well as Individual Student Plans (IEP's), ELL grades (AIP's) and other student data which is part of our school database, MyEd BC. This is an important component of how our school delivers student information to parents and families and will be used all the way through high school. It is important that parents set up this account and save a pdf copy of your child's reports as <u>hard copies will not be sent home and will not be provided from the school office.</u>

<u>New this year</u>: all reports will remain in your Family Portal account until July 31st, 2024. This allows parents plenty of time to download and save a copy of their child(ren)'s report.
