Emergency Student Release Drill

Gleneagles will be holding a full-scale **Emergency Student Release Drill on Thursday, April 25**th beginning at 1:00 pm and <u>parents are asked to mark their calendars for this date.</u>

This drill plays an important part of our school's emergency preparedness plan and gives us important feedback on some of the issues that we may encounter in the event of an earthquake or other disaster.

Students will be released through a formal process and a staggered timeline. Details around this drill will be emailed out to parents closer to the drill date. We understand that not all parents will be available to pick up their child early from school, however we appreciate your efforts in accommodating our request. Students who are not picked up early on this day will be dismissed at 2:35 pm as per usual and the Lions Bay bus will be running with its normal schedule.




