Solar Eclipse

As you are probably aware on **Monday, April 8th** a solar eclipse will occur when the Moon moves between the Sun and the Earth. In Metro Vancouver, this event will be a partial eclipse. It is expected to start around 10:40am and end around 12:20pm.

Did you know?

While it is dangerous to look at the sun anytime, the risk of harm is higher during a solar eclipse because we are more tempted to look, and some of our protective mechanisms that would make us turn away may be less effective due to lower light levels. Even during a partial eclipse, the sun's intense radiation can cause severe damage to the eyes. It's crucial to avoid looking directly at the sun during the eclipse, especially for children, as their eyes let in more light to the retina than adult eyes.



In consultation with Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH), schools in West Vancouver have created guidelines to help ensure student safety during the solar eclipse. This includes preventative measures for students to avoid

direct exposure like staying indoors if necessary, drawing blinds, educating students about potential risks, etc. This may result in our outdoor recess times being altered. Many classes will engage with learning about the solar eclipse and may even have the opportunity to join NASA experts online to watch the eclipse live though NASA's website.

This drill plays an important part of our school's emergency preparedness plan and gives us important feedback on some of the issues that we may encounter in the event of an earthquake or other disaster.

Students will be released through a formal process and a staggered timeline. Details around this drill will be emailed out to parents closer to the drill date. We understand that not all parents will be available to pick up their child early from school, however we appreciate your efforts in accommodating our request. Students who are not picked up early on this day will be dismissed at 2:35 pm as per usual and the Lions Bay bus will be running with its normal schedule.
