**Band Registration:** If your child is entering grade 6 or 7 in September and would like to join Band for the 2024-25 school year, please register through this link: <u>Elementary Band Program</u>.

Please note that staffing for next school year is dependent on the number of registrants for the Band program, and so we are encouraging families to register soon in order to help us secure the successful continuation of our Band program at GEC.

**BYOD Program:** All students entering grades 4 through 7 are asked to Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) to school to support student learning in the classroom. Students are asked to bring a laptop to school rather than a tablet as laptops are more conducive to the learning activities and tasks that students will be involved in. A very reasonable option for families is a <a href="Chromebook">Chromebook</a>. This device is very affordable and durable laptop option that has all of the required features that students will need.

**Bus Transportation:** Students living in the Lions Bay corridor between Gleneagles and Lions Bay are eligible to use the district bus service for the 2024-25 school year, if they complete an online registration form. **Online registration is now open <u>here</u>** and parents are asked to <u>register now.</u>

**IMPORTANT:** All Returning & New students' parents/guardians must submit an online request form for their eligible student(s). In order to adhere to legislated requirements to maintain accurate bus lists, registration is required for all school bus riders. Registration must occur prior to **July 15** of each year through an online request form on the district's website to be considered during the bus routing process. Please note that **school bus space may not be guaranteed for students that do not submit an Online Registration Form** (<a href="https://westvancouverschools.ca/transportation-form">https://westvancouverschools.ca/transportation-form</a>) or register after the deadline (July **15**, **2024**).

# **Classroom Placement Process for September 2024**

Please note: completed forms should be emailed to Mrs. Evans at <u>revans@wvschools.ca</u> and will <u>only be accepted until May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024</u>. Late submissions cannot be accommodated.

In May and June each year, we begin the process of planning for the next school year. Plans are tentative given the everchanging landscape and West Vancouver Schools' commitment to finding spaces for every student needing one. At this point, we anticipate most, if not all, of our classrooms will continue to be composed of combined (split) grades.

Our class placement process ensures that thoughtful consideration of each child's social, emotional, and academic needs are aligned with the need to create balanced and effective learning environments. The assignment of students to classes is decided by a team, which includes the School Based Resource Team, a child's current teacher, non-enrolling teachers, support staff and the administrators. The professional team considers each placement carefully as they create classes that include a wide range of students who learn in a variety of ways. In addition to individual circumstances, criteria considered in the placement process includes:

- 1. Workable instructional groups considering:
  - the child's academic needs and strengths;
  - teaching and learning styles;

- the child's work habits
- 2. Positive social groups considering:
  - placements where a child can work positively and productively with other children in the class;
  - peer supports or conflicts;
  - establishing the presence of positive leaders in each class
- 3. Balanced classes considering:
  - the differentiated needs of students;
  - social, emotional, and academic needs and abilities;
  - leadership abilities
- 4. Other information considered:
  - School-Based Resource Team recommendations

If you would like to provide input into this process, families may wish to complete a Placement Input Form. THIS IS OPTIONAL. It is not necessary to complete the form; many hours and great care are taken around the placement of every child to honour their individual learning style and create the best learning environment for all children. Please note that we will take into consideration Placement Input Forms, but it may not be possible to meet all requests. Our goal is to meet the needs of all students at Gleneagles Ch'axáý in order to maximize their growth as learners. We appreciate your support in this complex, multi-level process of arranging educationally sound and balanced classes.




